



Step 11

Once the band is in place and with the help of a razor we will cut out all the excess fabric.



Step 12

The sliding mosquito screen is ready to be placed in the window frame.

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


Assembly manualSliding Mosquito Screen




Step 1

Once the profiles have been cut to size, insert the brushes from the inside.




Step 2

Mount the upper and lower angles to their respective profiles.




Step 3

Insert brushes from the outside of the profiles.



Step 4

The brush must reach the end of the butt plate at a right angle.




Step 5

Insert the studs into the plugs of the crossbar until they protrude approximately 0.5 mm from the inside and place them at the ends of the crossbar.




Step 6

Measure the inside opening of the mosquito screen and mark it in the middle to place the crossbar.




Step 7

Clip the crossbar to the centre of the frame with the help of the marks on the caps and those we have marked previously.



Step 8

Cut the mosquito netting giving a surplus of 50 mm. larger than the interior hole of the frame.



Step 9

Insert the rubber seal to fix the fabric.
