




They can be installed from floor to ceiling, on walls or railings.

Azur Panoramic glass curtains are designed for non-trafficable spaces, i.e. to close gaps that cannot be traversed by people. For this reason, they are always opened from inside the home.

The Azur ST version is designed so that the bottom guide can be recessed, flush with the floor. This version is always installed from floor to ceiling, in transit areas and can open outwards. It is the ideal variant for porches and terraces as it allows traffic to pass through it.

Systems consisting of one or more sections of panels, with or without an opening in each section. As a general rule, there is no limitation on the length of the sections, taking into account that the number of leaves must be a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 9 per opening.

The width of the leaves or panels of the same section shall be between 400 and 1,000 mm. The height of the sections will vary between 500 and 3,000 mm, depending on the characteristics and needs, and may be different between adjacent sections, provided that they are not pass-angles.




Extended sliding profile




Terrace at 90° angle Picked up on one side (right)




Terrace 3 sides Pick up on 2 sides




Terrace 3 sides Pick up on 3 sides




Four-sided terrace with opening on both sides. 135° pass-angle
